<p>Evidence-based Practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on group experimental, single-case, and correlational research which:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ used methodologically sound research designs○ demonstrated a strong record of success for improving outcomes○ have undergone a systematic review process○ adhered to quality indicators related to specific research design
<p>Research-based Practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on group experimental, single-case, and correlational research which:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ used methodologically sound research designs○ demonstrated a sufficient record of success for improving outcomes○ may or may not have undergone a systematic review process○ may or may not adhere to quality indicators related to specific research design
<p>Promising Practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on group experimental, single-case, correlational, or qualitative research:<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ demonstrated limited success for improving outcomes○ may or may not have undergone a systematic review process○ may or may not adhere to quality indicators related to specific research design
<p>Unestablished Practices</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none">• Based on anecdotal evidence or professional judgment• Could include evidence from methodologically sound research studies which demonstrate <i>negative</i> effects
