In 2016, NTACT created a Teachers Pay Teachers (TPT) 'store' filled with resources that have been proven effective for implementing with youth with disabilities. Each product is based on high quality research and has been shown to be effective for secondary students with disabilities. NTACT resources are grounded in evidence-based and promising practices, vetted by experts in the field, and approved by the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education programs. While we can't guarantee that every resource may not be effective with every student, they have been proved to work with youth across the country. Each product is based on high quality research and has been shown to be effective for secondary students with disabilities.

What is Teachers Pay Teachers?

Teachers Pay Teachers (TPT) is an online marketplace where teachers can access, buy, and sell original educational materials. Teachers and practitioners can download materials. However, the lesson plans and materials may not be based on research. In order to reach more teachers and practitioners and provide them with instructional methods based on high quality research the National Technical Assistance Center on Transition (NTACT) created a Teachers Pay Teachers page to share free resources with teachers and practitioners.
